This autumn, in partnership with architect and TV presenter George Clarke's educational charity MOBIE, I will be launching a challenge for young Londoners to develop a masterplan for a new development close to where City Hall will be moving later this year.

The design challenge will invite young people to develop proposals for a new village in the Royal Docks, bringing the national curriculum to life and inspiring a new generation of Londoners to learn about the exciting career opportunities in the built environment sector.

The challenge will be set around four key themes central to London's recovery from COVID-19:

- 1. Improving Air Quality
- 2. Sustainable Transport
- 3. Affordable Housing
- 4. Green Energy

The attached brief gives a taster of what the challenge will involve, and the types of resources we will provide to support you and your students.
